

2016-2017 Annual Report

A milestone date like the 30th Anniversary of Family Support Line provides us an opportunity to reflect. Often we are so focused on the question of “what’s next?” that we don’t take the time to recognize and celebrate what we’ve built thus far. Our first program in 1988, even before we were incorporated as a nonprofit, focused on support groups for teen girls and non-offending parents, and we’ve grown a lot since then. In the last 30 years, our counseling program has offered 71 consecutive group sessions, over 200 groups have met, and over 1,000 lives have been touched with our message of hope and healing. We have no intention of slowing down either, as our mission to heal the hurt of child sexual abuse continues to drive us.

We have three goals for the future of Family Support Line as we continue on our mission:

Staff: Maintaining a high quality, well-trained staff that is available to survivors and families.

Space: Doubling the current available space for interviews with children in need of help.

Security: Securing our future for years to come so that survivors always have a safe place to go.

We cannot help but look back with gratitude and awe at all the lives we have been able to touch, and we look forward to serving our Delaware County community for another 30 years to come.

PROGRAMS

Prevention

- Provided *299 personal safety programs* that reached a total of 6,296 unique children.
- Conducted *54.5 hours of outreach and education* by participating in 20 different community health fairs and events around Delaware County.
- Conducted *3 focus groups* with local immigrant families to learn how to better engage and serve immigrant communities.
- Made a key piece of child sexual abuse prevention literature available in *13 languages* in order to better reach populations across language barriers.

Treatment

- Provided *700 hours of individual and family therapy* for 41 children and 27 adults.
- Started school-based, individualized psycho-education and mindfulness training to *3 child survivors*.
- Increased the number of group counseling sessions, and *added both summer and winter sessions*.
- Made group counseling sessions *more accessible and comfortable* for the community by moving them to our newly renovated office in Media.

Delaware County Children's Advocacy Center

- Opened *440 new cases* to seek justice for victims of child sexual abuse.
- *Increased forensic interviews by 10%* from the previous year.
- Welcomed *3 new staff members*: Susanne Whiting, Forensic Interviewer, Kristian Coronado, Family Advocate, and Lesi Elbirn, Family Advocate.
- Provided *3 trainings* as a resource to our multidisciplinary team.

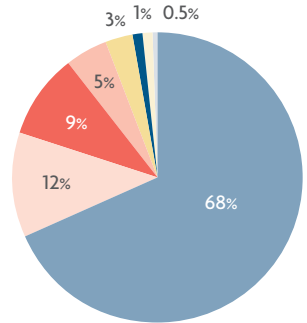

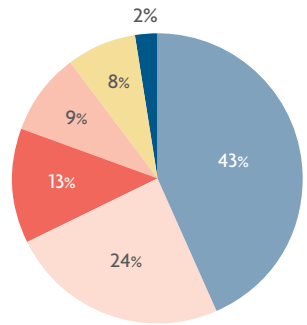
